## PUBLIC PLATFORM

Ever wanted to speed-date a neighbourhood? Get to know Claremont in a whole new way at Platform, our prototyping festival, a Western Australian first. It's part of FORM's PUBLIC2016, an annual festival of art, urban activation and creative conversations.

On 2 and 3 April, Platform stages a two-day creative takeover of Claremont. The Bayview Terrace area becomes an interactive wonderland of creative street activation experiments and installations, designed by some of Perth's brightest minds.

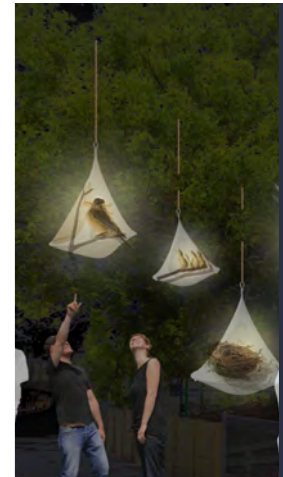
If you were offered a little piece of Claremont for 48 hours, what would you do with it? What would you offer passers-by? Something to listen to? Something to debate? Something to watch, or play, or to eat, or read? Find out what place-making solutions over 20 teams of Perth creatives—artists, sculptors, architects, engineers, designers and local retailers—have come up with.

The most effective installation will win the Judges' Choice Award of \$20,000, to be announced at the PUBLIC2016 opening party, 6-10pm, Saturday 2 April at the Claremont Quarter Forecourt. Everyone's welcome. There's also a People's Choice Award of \$5000 – make sure you cast your vote!

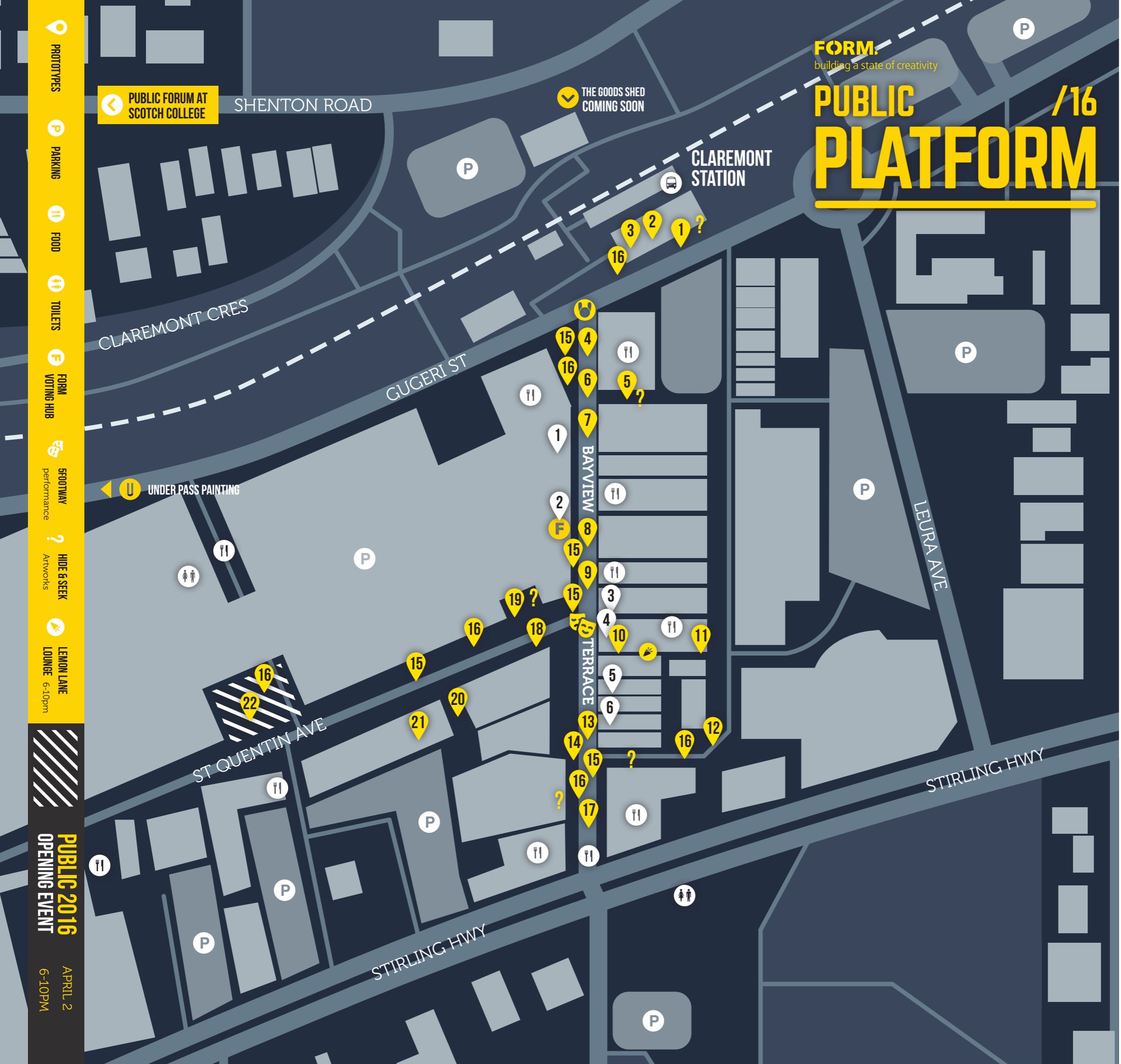
